In the general contracting categories, **Nabholz** won the Commercial category for their work on the Payne's Valley 19th Hole Bar & Restroom project. The winner in the Healthcare category was also **Nabholz** for their work on the HCA TMCA Geriatric Dementia Renovations project. **Straub Construction** won in the Historical Restoration/Renovation – Under \$10 Million category with their project on the Christ Community Church. The winner in the Public Works/Environmental – Under \$10 Million was also **Crossland Heavy Contractors**, with their Nall Avenue Pumping Station project. The winner in the Residential category was **Neighbors Construction Company** with The Donovan Apartments project. **Emery Sapp & Sons, Inc.** won the Specialty category for their I-44 Bridge Rebuild project. The winner of the Historical Restoration/Renovation – Over \$10 Million was **MW Builders** for their Flashcube Apartments project. **Emery Sapp & Sons, Inc.** won in the Infrastructure category for their I-70 & I-435 Interchange project. **Excel Constructors** won the Institutional – Over \$10 Million category for their Donnelly College project.

The award of Top General Contractor went to **MW Builders** for their Flashcube Apartments project. The Top Subcontractor was awarded to **hth companies, inc.** for their Tate & Lyle Boiler 6 project.

The Arthur C. Waugh Keystone Award went to **Preston Moore** of Nabholz.

In the safety categories, the Subcontractor Safety Award went to **Lee Mechanical Contractors**. The General Contractor Safety Award went to **Crossland Heavy Contractors**. The winner of the Ted Anderson Superior Safety Award was **TIC – The Industrial Company**.
